



Children's Theatre of Cedar Rapids Grant Application

What is Children's Theatre?

Children's Theatre of Cedar Rapids, Inc, (CT) is a non-profit organization that facilitates the production of child friendly plays in cooperation with area high schools. The high schools currently involved in these productions are Jefferson HS, Kennedy HS & Washington HS. The Children's Theatre Board consists of 30 volunteer members who approve the scripts, oversee and promote the plays. The primary aim of The Children's Theatre is to encourage the production of high quality educational and entertainment programs for children via the dramatic and interpretive arts.

Who is Eligible?

The Children's Theatre grant is available to any Linn County area Middle School or High School, not currently working with the Children's Theatre, who is interested in presenting an educational dramatic event for young children.

Grant Guidelines and Expectations

Middle School and High School applicants will be expected to produce a theatrical event for children who are pre-school to elementary age. The event may be a play or other type of presentation, for example, a theater camp for elementary students. Specific details of the event must be included with this application. In the event that a "play" will be produced, applicants must supply a draft script of the production to The Children's Theatre for review and approval. Should the applicant be chosen, CT also reserves the right to approve the final script. CT must be notified of the date and time of the dress rehearsal so that CT members may attend for the purpose of providing evaluation. Any suggestions or recommendations made by CT should be adopted when it is practical to do so.

Applicants are responsible for promotion, tickets sales, providing staff to work at the venue, and any other production costs. The Children's Theatre would receive no proceeds from ticket sales at this production. The CT logo will be used only on playbills with the claim "made possible in part by a contribution from The Children's Theatre of Cedar Rapids".

Total Grant Money Awarded

Provided that the applicant meets the guidelines and expectations, a total of **\$500** will be rewarded upon completion of the event or production.

Grant Application Deadline

Applications must be postmarked no later than **November 12th 2009**. Applications marked after this date will not be considered. CT does not assume responsibility for postal delays or misrouting.

Answer all questions in detail with specific information regarding the production as well as the venue you are planning to use. Submit a copy to:
